COVID-19 Assembly Guidelines Update Masks are "Strongly Encouraged"

As was mentioned Sunday, we are continuously monitoring the situation with COVID-19 in Montgomery County, and two things have happened this past week. First, our hospital is seeing a rise in patients being treated for the virus. And second, our County Mayor has issued an executive order extending through next Monday that face coverings or masks are to be worn inside all businesses in the county. Although churches are exempt from this requirement, the order "strongly encourages" everyone attending those gatherings to wear face coverings to help

prevent a possible spread of the virus. In light of both of these developments, the elders are also strongly encouraging everyone to wear some sort of face covering to our 10:00 worship assembly this coming Sunday. If you or your family members are in need of masks, they will be available at our Welcome Center. We realize that many people have differing views on this matter, but we encourage mutual respect for each other during this most unusual time.
