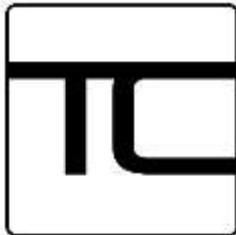


To the Church of Christ at Trenton Crossing
