- **Rehab:** Linda Crow is in Skyline Hospital Rehab Center (Room 269), and she is doing very well.

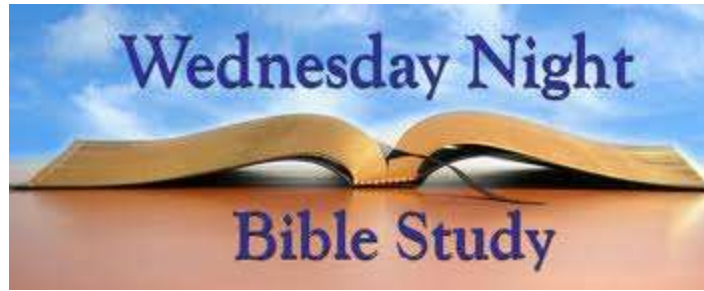
Lovetta Wright is in Tennova Rehab (Room 4102) following surgery and is doing well.
