A donation was made in memory of Ruth Sawyers (Tammy Sharp's mother) to the F.U.E.L. Ministry by Granville and Patsy Deen.



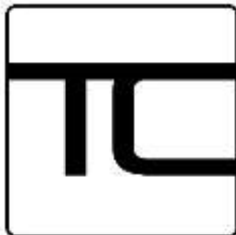
Togo Mission Work
