A donation was made in memory of Shirley Wallace (mother of Kim Haley and Melanie Wallace) to World Bible School by Wilton and Glenda McKinney.



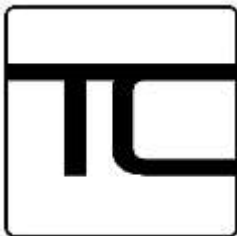
Ramps for Christ
