QPR Suicide Prevention November 7

QPR (**Question, Persuade, and Refer**) Gatekeeper Training for Suicide Prevention is an educational program designed to teach the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to respond. Just like CPR, QPR is an emergency response to someone in crisis and can save lives. Eric and Erin Yow are certified instructors of QPR and would like to train you in the life-saving technique.

Sunday, November 7, following our morning worship assembly, we will provide lunch to those who want to learn QPR. The class will begin after lunch, and it will be completed in time for everyone to be at the Tennessee Veterans' Home by 2:30 in order to participate in the TN Veterans' Parade. (See box below.)

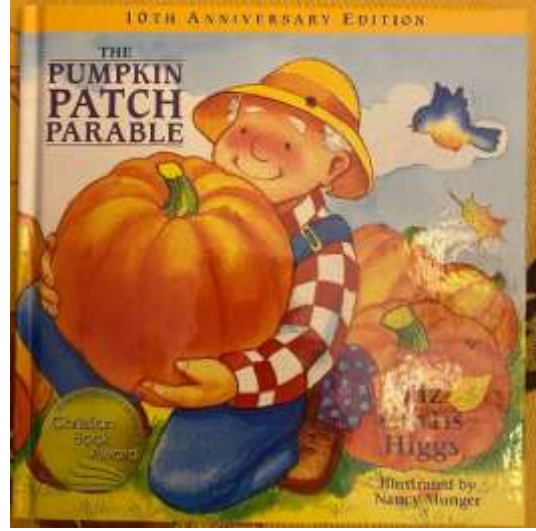




Wednesday Night Learning Fun!!
