QPR (**Question, Persuade, and Refer**) Gatekeeper Training for Suicide Prevention is an educational program designed to teach the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to respond. Just like CPR, QPR is an emergency response to someone in crisis and can save lives. Eric and Erin Yow are certified instructors of QPR and would like to

train you in the life-saving technique.
