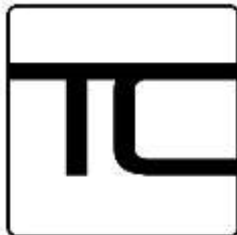
Dorcas Ministry and our TC Elementary Kids
