VBS Collections

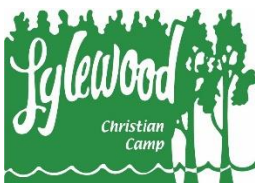

Thank you in advance for your participation and support for those in need in our community.

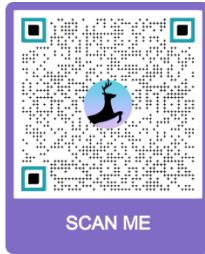

Teachers Needed

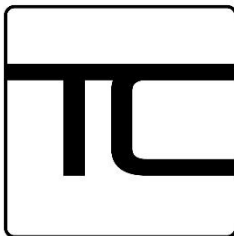
