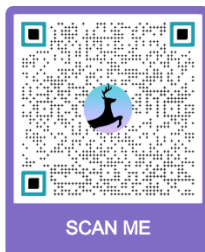
We are collecting:

- Socks - all sizes, ages, and genders
- Underwear - all sizes, ages, and genders (only boxer briefs for men)
- Deodorant
- Toothpaste and toothbrushes
- Shampoo - travel size, not hotel size
- School Supplies - pencils, small sharpeners, 16 pack crayons or coloring pencils, erasers,

coloring book (ages 2-7), spiral notebook or composition notebook (ages 7 and above)

As you donate items in the boxes, we ask that you sign your family's name on the sheet beside the box. Your family's name will then be placed on a box, and during VBS week, the collection of boxes will become a wall of "Answered Prayers" for those in need. **The "Answered Prayer" wall has already started.** The foundation was laid by our members who can no longer worship with us. The Children's Change collections from this quarter will be used to purchase items for the boxes in honor of those members. As of today, 10 other families have contributed. We encourage all families and individuals to contribute to this cause. We are hoping for 150 families or more to participate.

or one quarter at a time. See Gwyn Huggins, Megan Kent, or BJ Worthington if you can help.

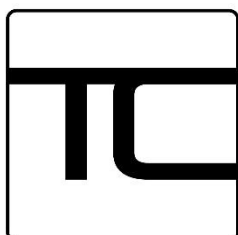
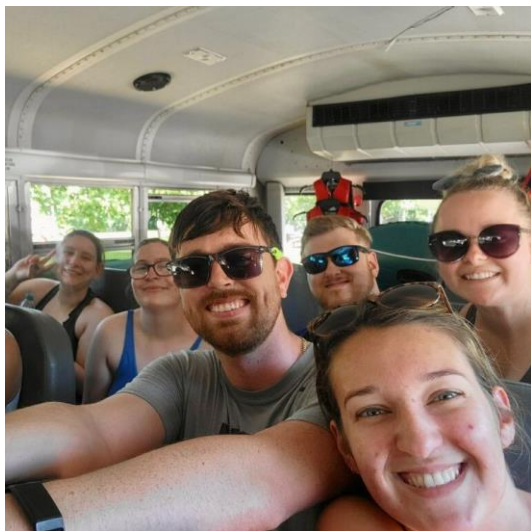
WBS Malawi
