Applications to apply for the TC Scholarship Fund are available on the table outside the church office. The deadline to apply is **THIS Sunday**, June 5.

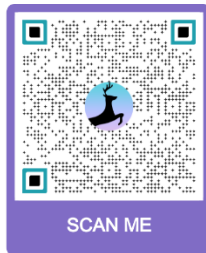

We need a few items and a few volunteers to help with our decorating. We need:

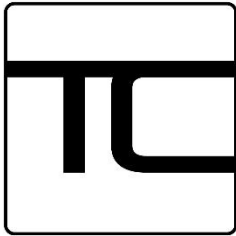
- Any green/brown silk leaved bushes or vines you wish to get rid of
