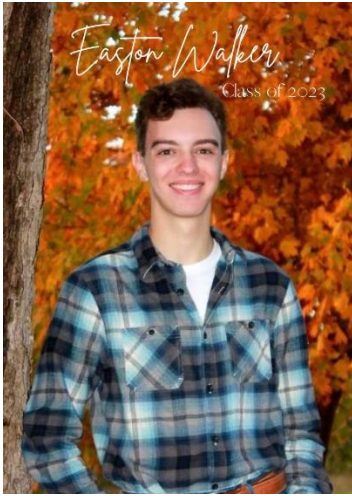

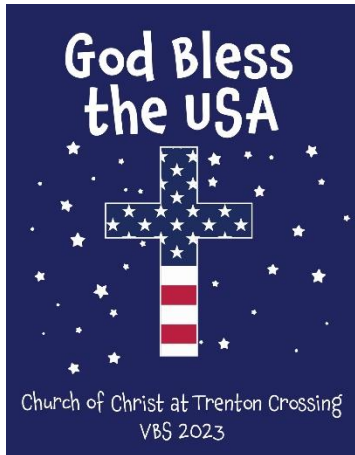

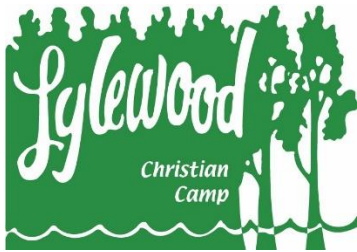
TC VBS

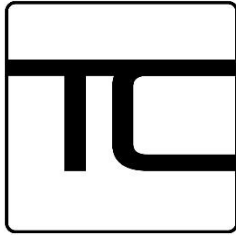
