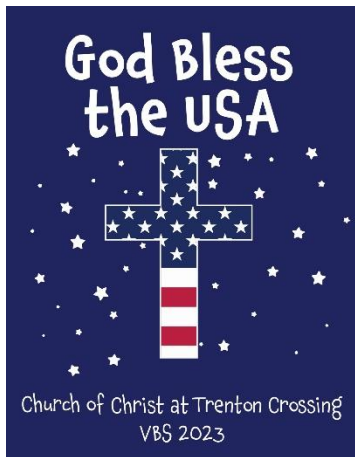
Worship Assembly.

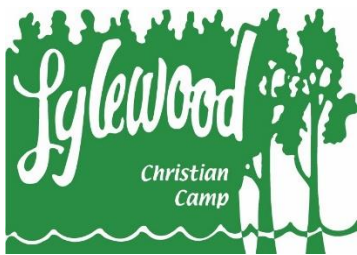
Blessing Project

Garrett, son of Travis and Lauren Merchant, is graduating from Pleasant View Christian School. He plans to attend APSU and study History/Political Science.



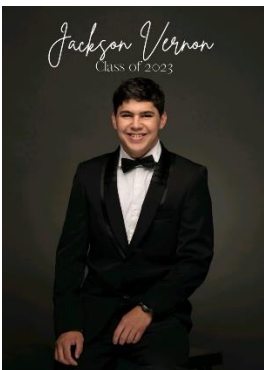
Kendra Roberts

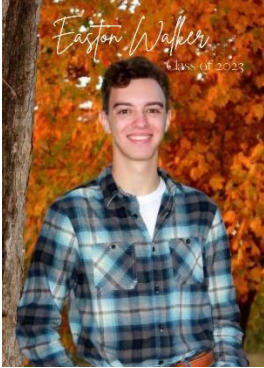
Robert Thompson

Easton, son of Eric and Kelly Walker, is graduating as the Valedictorian of Jo Byrns High School. He plans to attend UT Martin and study Biology.



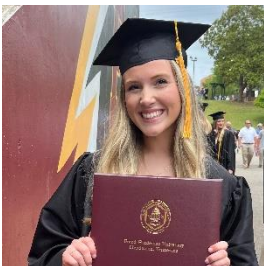
Kiki Bell

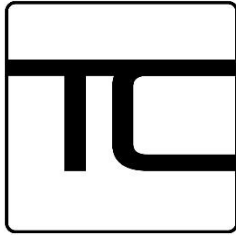
David Judd
